1. Approve minutes from April meeting.
2. Approve minutes from May Meeting. Susan agreed to scribe for the meeting.
3. Chalk-up – Carol, Jim-
 - A. Jim Gilman brought in Chalk-up posters for sandwich sign.
 - B. Judges- Tracy R. will be our judge. John Moore will print prizes. Kathy will make contact for scholarships – mainly Florence Crittendon.
 - C. Misc. - Jim will get a one day permit from city to unload. Water will be set up and ready to go and we will use cones and tape to keep people off art.
 - D. Publicity- gift card donations for prizes, email to parks and recreation for clean-up the day before. Posters were passed out for each committee member to distribute. Kathy will contact Indian fry bread vendor and possible boy scout/ girl scouts.
 - E. Radio and TV publicity- committee members were assigned to handle each of these.
 - F. Volunteers- need help with registration and night before marking off sidewalk. Committee members Bart, Kathy, Carol and Susan will help with night before. Kathy will put in Friday Independent Record a volunteers needed post.
 - G. Registration – Judy will register people at her office in city and county building Mon.-Thurs. morning. Carol will register after Thurs. – Kathy and Jim will be at the registration table to help on Sat. morning.
4. At 4:00, John had to leave the meeting and Carol Montgomery acted as chair.
5. Parking Meter Project- Carol reported that all were installed except Grandstreet which will install their own. The article from Independent Record was shared with everyone and it was great publicity. There was a question about the keys to the meters and Carol will follow up on this. A suggestion was made that maybe a few of the meters could be turned so everyone could have a better view of them.
6. Art Questionnaire- The website still isn't working right so that we can tally results. Judy will check into this.
7. Spring Art Walk- Susan reported on this and it was successful. We had an attendance of roughly 75 people to the HPAC area. The artist Rachel Twoteeth did a great job.
8. DHI membership proposal- A proposal was made to do a group membership with some other organizations as the cost is \$195.00 and would not be cost effective for HPAC to

pay alone as our two events only need permits that cost \$80.00. Katherine will look into this.

9. Transportation Alternatives – Call for project applications. Kathy will look into this. A proposal would be to have HPAC take care of the centennial trail tunnels with interactive lighting or other options. HPAC would be interested.
10. Parking Garage Mural project-
 - A. Dimensions are 1530 sq. ft. with 400 sq. ft. block retaining wall.
 - B. Bobi has spoken with Dennis McCann and he was excited about being involved with project. A suggestion was made to possibly portray a Livery Station.
 - C. Possible sub-committee to work on this. Bart and Bobi will be involved in this.
11. Public Comment Katherine discussed the 1% suggestion for building permit on value of the building to be used for public art. This suggestion was brought up before the city commissioners and the HPAC committee members discussed this.
